Sides and Back	Indian Rosewood (Dalbergia Latifolia) binding top and back
Purfling	Indian Rosewood (Dalbergia Latifolia)
Fingerboard	African Ebony (Diospyros Crassiflora)
Neck	Brazilian Cedar (Cedrela Odorata)
Bridge	Indian Rosewood (Dalbergia Latifolia)
Head	Indian Rosewood (Dalbergia Latifolia)
Finish	Polyurethane
